





Dropped Object Project Objective

- Improve dropped object performance of equipment installed at height and equipment placed at height intermittently
- Develop technical requirements covering the equipment life cycle (design, fabrication, transportation, installation, commissioning, operation, maintenance and de-commissioning)
- Supplement with a drops maintenance program on board for personnel and asset protection
- Publish a technical resource guide developed with Industry
- Incorporate optional class designations demonstrating compliance with the developed process.
