

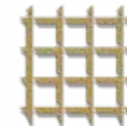

An overview of DROPS Awareness Seminars 2010 -2011



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Given the nature and severity of Dropped Object incidents and the industry focus, Dolphin Drilling Ltd (DDL) commenced a programme of education for all its core teams across the fleet in 2010.

The programme that was developed, in conjunction with, Global TCC, its training provider looked to deliver an homogenous message in line with the DROPS initiative, that allowed the issues and the solutions being developed by DDL to be delivered in a thought provoking manner.

These seminars which have been continually amended from their inception have kept pace with industry changes and DDL Process improvements.

The Seminars' set out to look out the following areas in terms of training and awareness to enhance the technical and procedural aspects of the issue of 'Dropped Objects' that were being implemented on each of the MODU's;

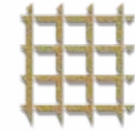
- raise awareness To raise awareness of Dropped Objects and their consequences through a number of different media.
- To assist with identifying and assessing potential Dropped Objects while planning and monitoring tasks
- To assist with identifying controls for prevention and mitigation of potential Dropped Objects

The programme has encompassed all personnel on board each of the UKCSs MODU's, including all disciplines and onshore Management. To date the total number of personnel who have attended is 223 and the programme is due to be rolled out to the international fleet in 2012.

This has been supported by the QHSE Department who have assisted with the overall development and delivery of the programme, and whose input has been fundamental in achieving the required results. .



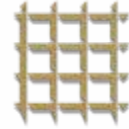
