Door swung open on tool container the first lift they took off.





The piece of wood is a cover off a crate with approx dimensions 80cm x 60 cm x 7mm thick.





Crane operator noticed what looked to be a loose section of packing case wood on top of the crate. Once outside the 500m zone inspection showed it to be a section of packing case timber approx. 25mm x 75mm x 700mm long with six exposed nail ends some 40mm long.








The crane was lifting a heavy lift - 12.7 tonnes from our deck, on the way up he bumped into our outer rail, on port aft, so it broke. The ship was pitching/heaving due to some swell, but within working limits, The crane operator had miscalculated the distance of the lift & and movement of the ship.







Small shackle dropped from crane

Rig later confirmed that the shackle came from one of the small floodlights on the boom
