## Foundation in Gov. White Papers

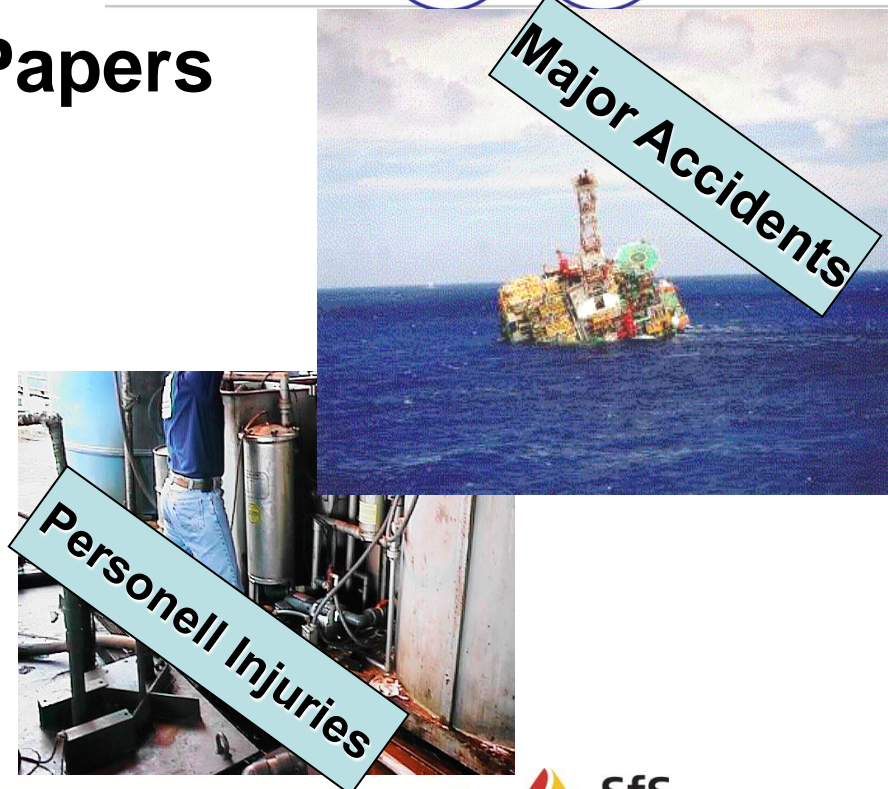
### Mandate:

# Work in SfS

## Principles:

- Tripartite cooperation
- Subject Matter Experts + users in work groups
- Employee involvement critical to ensure operability/ownership



## Status May 2012:

- 10 Seminars/conferences
- >40 Work Groups established
- 33 Recommendations published
- 26 Safety movies

- **Hot work – Chemical health risks**
- **Common alarms and signals (Onshore sites)**
